

# Future Writers Programme Evaluation Summary 2022-23

## What is Future Writers?

The Future Writers programme is a multi-activity programme consisting of progression awareness activities, academic and communication workshops and incorporated a competition element with the overall aim of stimulating, motivating, and encouraging a learner's knowledge, interest, and ability in relation to English literature and language, including Creative Writing.

## Who was involved?

- 4 Schools
- 541 pupils from Years 9 or 10 were involved in at least one activity
- Delivery was supported with academic staff from 2 universities
- 130 pupils submitted a competition entry

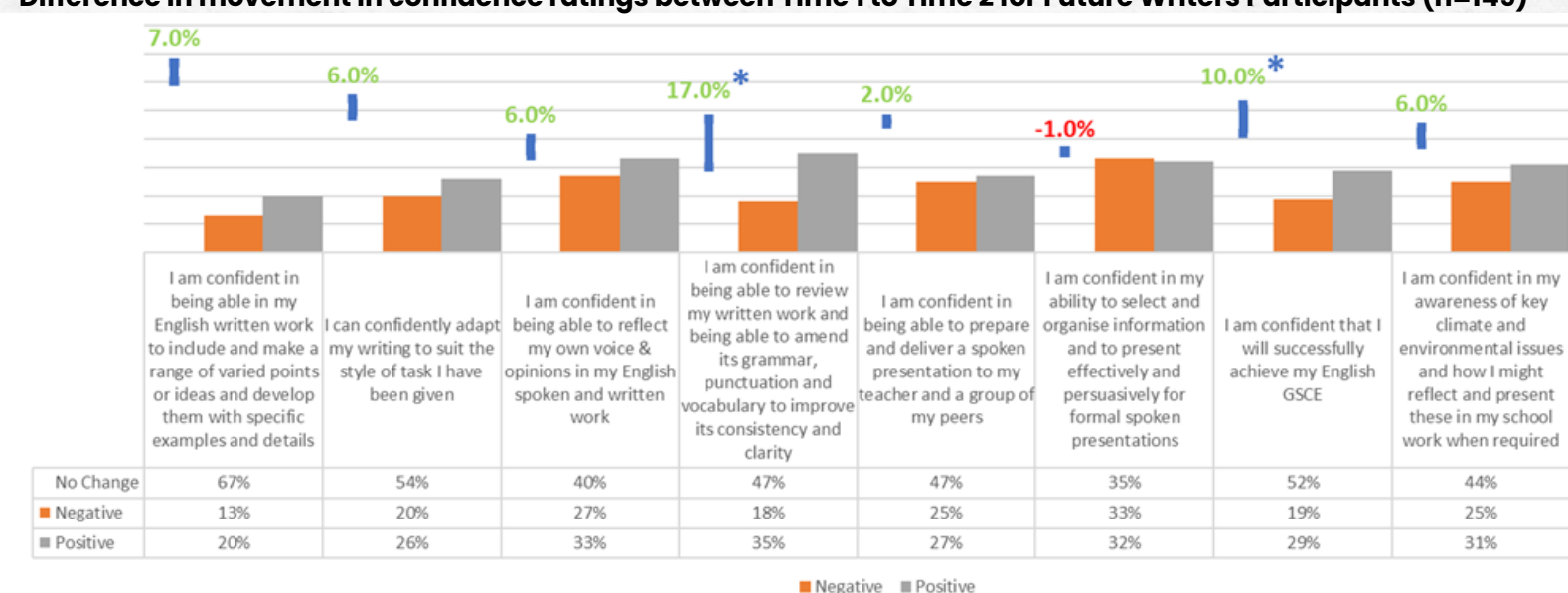
## Key Findings

- Participation in the Future Writers programme showed a measurable self-reported positive change in confidence for learners in respect of some identified English GSCE curriculum outcomes.
- The Future Writers programme was identified as a positive, interesting, enjoyable, and engaging programme. Participation in some elements of the programme were, for some participants, positively associated with influencing their future education and career options.
- Participation in the Future Writers programme appeared to increase academic attainment in English for participants in one school out of the three schools from where attainment data was available.
- The Future Writers programme provides a positive platform for further iteration and could be potentially applied to other academic subjects.

## How did we evaluate?

- Developed a Theory of Change
- Use of a confidence questionnaire administered at three time points
- Assessed any change on pre and post programme involvement in assessed English subject attainment
- Structured wrap-up evaluation session
